# INTRODUCTION

Gandacharra Sub-Division was created on 14<sup>th</sup> April, 1989 A.D. with 36 nos. of Revenue Moujas bifurcating the Amarpur and Kamalpur Sub-Divisions. Prior to its creation, the Sub-Division was a Revenue Circle of the Amarpur Sub-Division, South Tripura District. The Sub-Division is situated neighbouring Longtharai Valley, Ambassa and Amarpur Sub-Division. It is surrounded by Bangladesh in the east and south and to the north by Ambassa Sub-Division and to the west by Amarpur Sub-Division. The area of the Sub-Division is 596.22 Sq Kms. Gandacharra Sub-Division is situated in the Kalajhari hill range.

Most of the Revenue Villages of this Sub-Division are situated at the hilly and low-lying areas and the compositions of soil of these areas are gravel mixed with loose sandy and red soil which makes it prone to land-slide. Most of the villagers live in tong-houses (traditional dwelling house of tribal) build in the hilly areas. A mild storm /cyclone/heavy rain can create loss of a vital part of public property. The Raima and Saima rivers flows towards north direction.

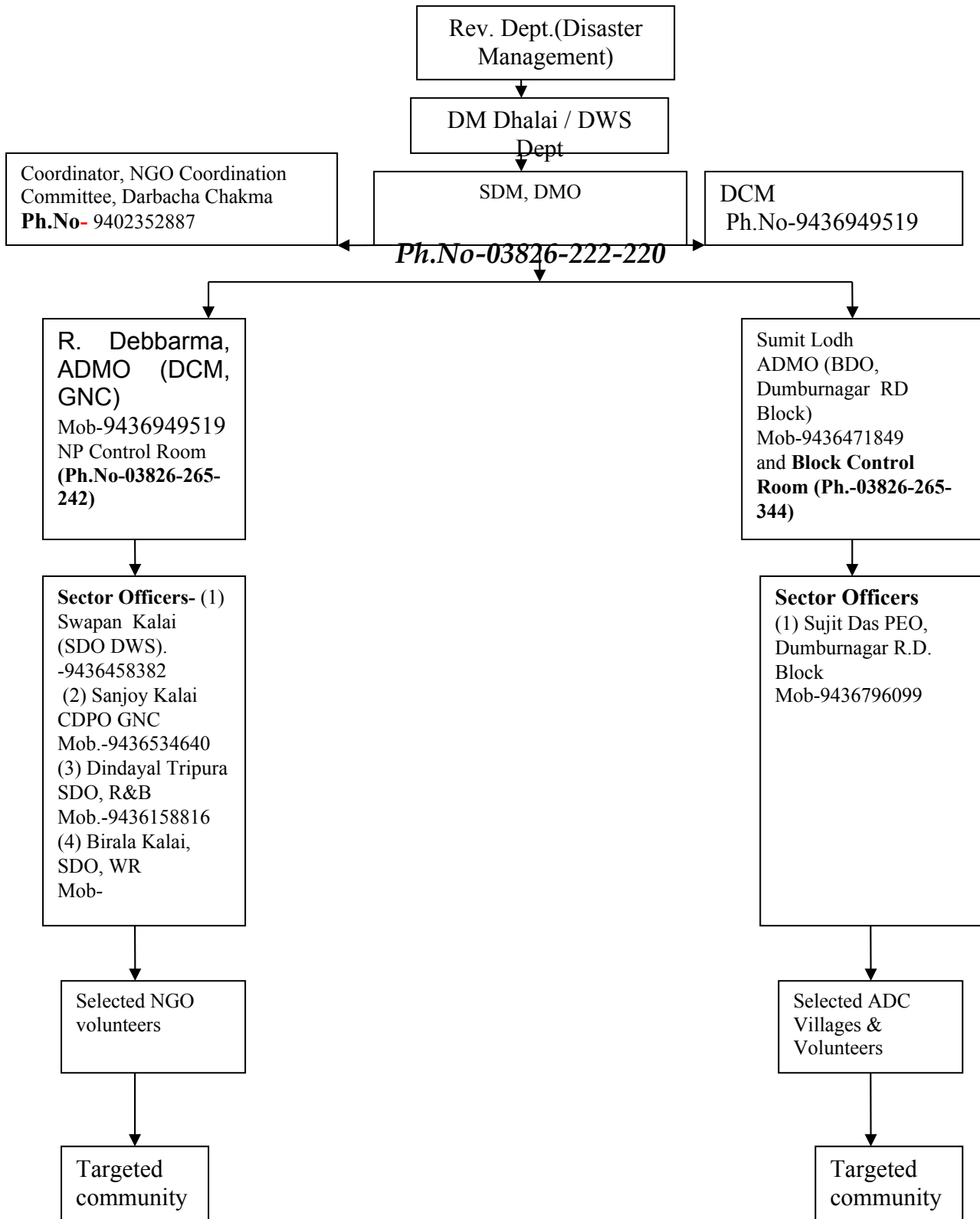

**Warning System.**

Review of existing warning and forecasting system has been made by the Sub-Divisional Magistrate Gandacharra for tackling the flood situation. The Tehsildars of this Sub-Division shall follow the instructions given by the SDM from time to time.

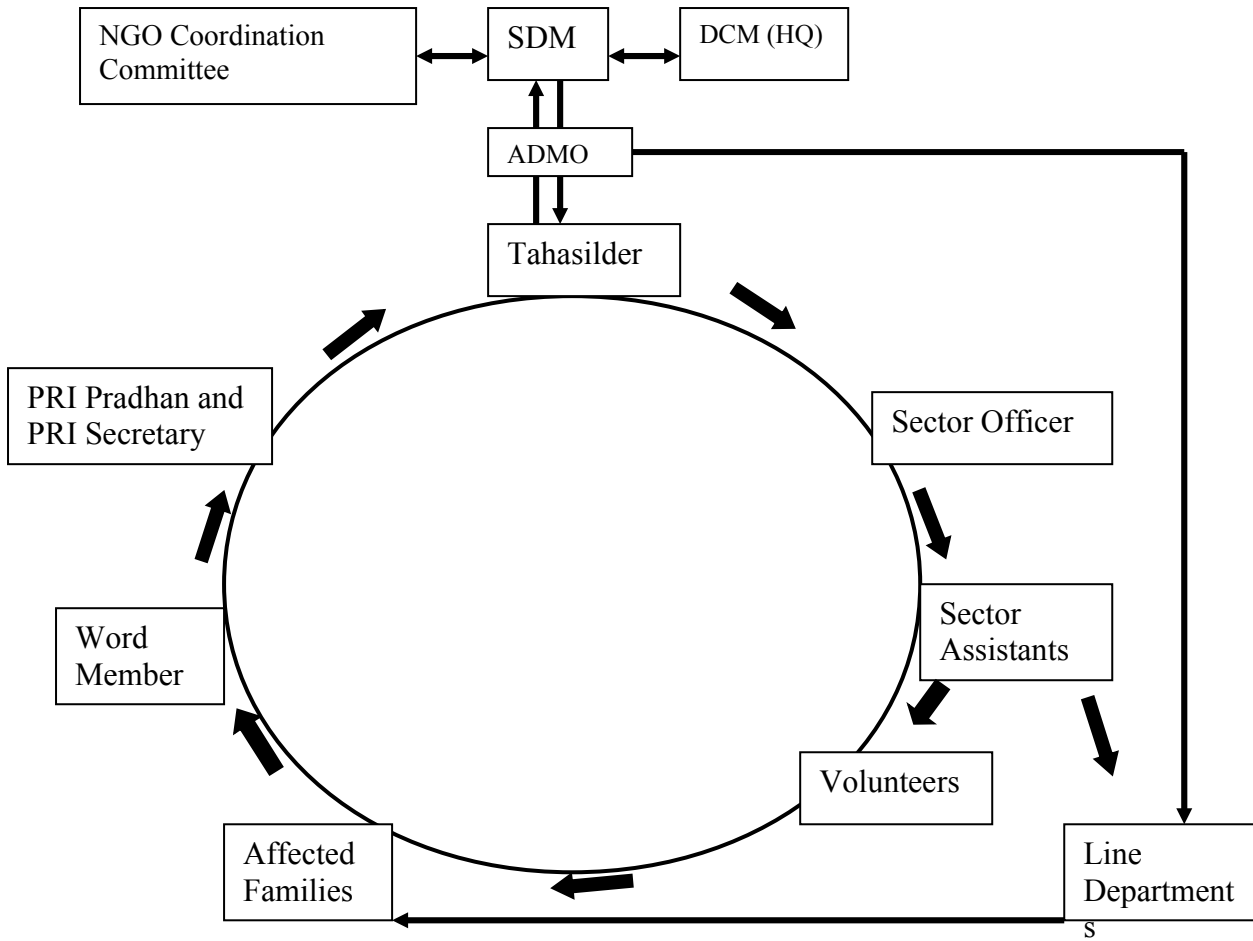
