

## **TOUR NOTE OF ABHISHEK SINGH, IAS, D.M & COLLECTOR, DHALAI DISTRICT FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER 2011.**

**16-11-2011**

I attended an administrative cum-health camp at Sanaiya Reang Para in Setrai VC of Kamalpur Sub-Division on 16-11-2011. During the camp, the SDM, Kamalpur; BDO, Salema; SDMO, Kamalpur and district & sub-divisional level line departments' officials also accompanied me. I also visited various development works under taken in the village under MGNREGA, tribal welfare schemes, drinking water & sanitation schemes and other line departments schemes in the area alongwith the concerned officials.

The following are my observations during the said visit, which require immediate action from concerned officials.

1. The works taken under MGNREGA must have signboard at the work site and it should be ensured by the concerned Implementing Agency immediately.
2. The 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> weeding of the bamboo plantation taken by the Forest Department under MGNREGA should be ensured immediately.
3. The innovative drinking water source being developed by drinking water & sanitation department at a nearby natural water reservoir should be made functional at the earliest. The TSECL shall provide necessary connection with least cost to this source within November, 2011.
4. The road from Sanaiya Reang Para to Darlong Basti is already being constructed by PWD(TTAADC) Department. Therefore, the fund placed to EE, PWD(R&B, Kamalpur for this purpose need not be spent. The EE, PWD(R&B), Kamalpur shall submit alternative proposal outside the PWD core network or the PMGSY works, which are urgently required in the sub-division.

5. The demand for extension of market area may be looked into by the SDM, Kamalpur and feasibility study & available options may be explored by the EE, PWD(R&B), Kamalpur in consultation with the market committee.
6. The EE, PWD(DWS), Kamalpur shall ensure minor repair of the PVC pipe line for the innovative drinking water source created in Darlongbasi (Upper Sikarpara).
7. The drinking water source at Bacchamura should be further developed by the EE, PWD(DWS), Kamalpur so as to provide by water supply from the existing RCC well with the help of submersible pump as discussed. He is also requested to take up drinking water project from small water reservoir with minor filtering arrangements to provide tap water supply in nearby areas.
8. The issue of govt. khas land at Baralutma as raised by local inhabitants should be enquired into by the SDM, Kamalpur and he shall submit a report within 10 days.

All concerned are requested to take necessary action as mentioned above and send the action taken report within 10 days.
