

TOUR NOTE OF ABHISHEK SINGH, IAS, D.M & COLLECTOR, DHALAI DISTRICT FOR VISIT TO DUMBURNAGAR RD BLOCK

19-03-2012

I visited Manikpur, Chawmanu RD Block on 19-03-2011 alongwith SDM, LTV; SDPO, LTV; BDO, CMN; SDMO, LTV; SDO, DWS, CMN; Sr. Manager, TSECL, CMN and other officials. Following of my observations during the said visit to the different places which require necessary action from the concerned officials.

Manikpur PHC:

- The Manikpur PHC is run from an old building which does not have adequate place at present and it is not yet upgraded to 24x7 IPHS category. The new building being constructed by PWD Department near the Growth Centre is yet to be completed. Therefore, there is a need to expedite the work of construction of PHC building PWD(R&B) department and hand over it to the Health Department so that further facility of 24x7 at PHC can be started in the area which is affected by dry spell and water borne disease every year during this time.

(Action by EE,PWD(R&B), MNU)

- The Ambulance placed to the PHC was not found on the day of visit and the record related to movement of Ambulance was also not available. Availability of Ambulance at eh PHC should ensured all the time.
- The SDMO, LTV shall ensure proper and judicious utilization of this Ambulance and maintenance of proper records by the MOI/C. There is a need to have another Ambulance in this area since most of the patients are referred to the Chawmanu PHC which has IPD facility.

(Action by CMO,DLI)

- From the records, it was found that only two patients were referred to the next level since January, 12 which indicate that either patients are not returned or patients directly approach to Chawmanu PHC or other PHC without approaching Manikpur PHC. Due to this, they might be losing the provision/facility of referral transport or reimbursement of cost of referral. The CMO, Dhalai to look into this matter.

(Action by CMO,DLI)

- The records with respect to JSY/JSSK, incentive to ASHA, stock of medicines etc. were not maintained properly and not updated. The same should be done by 31-03-2012.
- Cash payment is being made for JSY/JSSK benefits which should have been discontinued by March, 2012.

(Action by SDMO,LTV)

- A good amount is still lying under RKS, untied fund and maintenance works for the PHC should be utilized properly and immediately.

(Action by MOI /C, MKP PHC)

- Out of three nos. of Doctor only one Doctor Sujit Das was available on the day of visit. He reported that the stock of medicines, particularly addition medicine for water borne disease and gastroenteritis is required immediately.

(Action by CMO,DLI)

Visit to Khasmaypara Re-grouping Village:

- The families from East & West Malidhar Village Committees have regrouped at Khasmanipara on the way from Malidhar much to Chakbeha. Presently, 60-70 families have occupied the area though more than 200 families were supposed to regroupe at this place. As reported by BDO, Chawmanu around 200 IAY houses have been provided to these families from RoFR/IAY as an incentive in regrouping. Yet, many of them are to occupy the village.
- It has been noticed that the involvement of Forest Department has been least for the regrouping in this village though the Forest Department is the nodal agency for regrouping. The DFO, TTAADC, 82 miles and the Range Officer, Chawmanu are requested to actively pursue & coordinate with different agencies to provide basic infrastructure in the area. DFO,Manau may also take initiative till transition is made from Forest Department State Govt to TTAADC.

(Action by DFO,MNU/DFO,TTAADC,82 Miles)

- The SDM,LTV alongwith the DFO, TTAADC, 82 miles may look into the matter regarding non-availability of additional land for the construction of homestead for the remaining families as there are some land dispute with respect to

patta land in the area. Efforts should be made to provide basic needs the willing families.

**(Action by
SDM,LTV/DFO,TTAADC,82 Miles)**

- There is no drinking water source available in the vicinity of this regrouped village which has made it prone to water borne disease in the ensuing dry spell period. As discussed, BDO, CMN shall take up construction of one ring well at nearby location as identified and some other temporary wells. SDO,DWS, CMN shall arrange for water through syntax tank/other means till the work of ring well is completed.

(Action by SDO,DWS,CMN/BDO,CMN)

- The SDM,LTV is requested to provide individual benefit to the families already regrouped from the Tribal Welfare schemes as an incentives in consultation with the PRI bodies.

**(Action
by SDM,LTV)**

- Once ongoing construction work of the road up to Hajirai is completed, this regrouped village would be connected with Manikpur. The EE, PWD(R&B), MNU is requested to ensure completing formation of road up to this regrouped village alongwith the brick soling before monsoon so that the connectivity is maintained even during the monsoon period.
- It was reported by the inhabitants that job cards are kept with the panchayet or members of the panchayet which is complete violation of MGNREGA operation guideline. The BDO, CMN shall ensure handing over of all the job cards including the new job cards to the concerned families at the earliest. For updation of job cards, in no case it should be kept at any other level for more than a week. Many of them were also not issued the smart card for payment in the BC model. The BDO, CMN shall take up the matter with the concerned person.

(Action by BDO,CMN)

Inspection of Village Office of East & West Malidhar:

- During the inspection of the office records alongwith BDO, CMN, it was observed that most of the records including cash book, receipt register, I/O advance register, muster roll register, work register & asset register etc. were not maintained and updated regularly. In fact, the cash book was last updated in January, 12 and since thus, it was not updated. The BDO, CMN shall ensure all those registers and records updated in the Village Committee

Office by 31-03-2012. Until the salary of the two RPS & two GRS shall be kept withheld.

(Action by BDO,CMN)

- A sum of Rs.51,000/- was drawn by Sri S.N.Tripura, GRS from the MGNREGA fund in cash for which no work order or sanction memo is produced. Further, the work of kachha road from Malidhar to Rampajoy house (1 km) was taken up under MGNREGA as per the work order dt. 16-07-2011. However, the fund was drawn & placed in the account of the beneficiary in advance on 29-06-2011 only. Therefore, the BDO,CMN shall enquire into the matter and take strict action against the officials involved. An action taken report shall be submitted within 15 days in this regard. The BDO, CMN shall also issue show cause to the AAO who was supposed to inspect the cash book monthly.

(Action by BDO,CMN)

- Similarly, many of the records were also not maintained in West Malidhar VC. From the bank account statement/passbook it was revealed that a sum of Rs.23,000/- & Rs.35,000/- were withdrawn in cash by GRS against which no work order/sanction memo could be produced. Further, I/O advance taken so far by all the I/Os have not been adjusted till now. The BDO,CMN shall enquire into the matter and take necessary action as per the provision.

(Action by BDO,CMN)

- On the way back to the Manikpur I held meeting with the Chairman & Vice-Chairman of East & West Malidhar VCs, Manikpur VC, Rajdhar VC and Debacherra VC. It was revealed that the attendance of BC model is highly irregular with frequent instances of break down of BC machines/computers, non-supply of receipt/payment slip, insufficient currency/cash available with BC on the day of payment. They also requested for additional squatting plates against the damaged plates provided earlier to BPL families and for regrouping village at Khasmay para. The BDO, CMN shall examine & take up the matter with the competent authority for resolution of same. It was also reported that a TSR camp was proposed at Khasmay para regrouping village and the same has not been taken up till date. The SP, Dhalai & SDPO, LTV shall look into the matter with reference to the earlier decisions taken in this regard.

(Action by SP.DLI/SDPO,LTV/BDO,CMN)

- There was a demand for a call centre at Manikpur but due to non handing over of land by the TSECL, the same could not be taken up by the EE, RDD-II, MNU whom sufficient fund already been placed under BRGF. The DGM, MNU and Sr. Manager, TSECL, Manu shall identify the land in consultation with SDM, LTV and handover the same to EE, RDD-II, MNU by 24-03-2012 for taking up the construction of call centre at Manikpur. Meanwhile, temporary arrangement shall be made on the first floor of double storied building constructed under Growth Centre for accommodation of call centre till the building completed.
- Water tank constructed as a component of Growth Centre providing water to the shop keepers is yet to be operationalise due to technical fault in the pump. SDO, DWS, CMN & BDO, CMN shall jointly visit and resolve the issue as per the technical feasibility.

(Action by BDO, CMN/SDO, DWS, CMN/Sr. Manager, TSECL. CMN)

All concerned are requested to take action accordingly and sand action taken report within 7(seven) days.
