

TOUR NOTE

On 08-11-2009 I started from Ambassa at 3:00 pm alongwith Sri Sajal Biswas, O/C, Development; Sri Subir Debbarma, DGM,TSECL, Ambassa; Sri Subrata Malakar, EE, RDD-I, Dhalai; Sri K.M. Jamatia, DEO, Ambassa; Sri Kumud Debbarma, Asstt. Director, Planning; Sri Jogendra Debbarma, O/C, NREGA. The main purpose of the visit was to inspect NREGA work and hold administrative camp at Bhagirath ADC Village. I reached at Gandacherra at 6:00 pm after having a brief halt for one hour at Ganganagar. The main points are as follows:-

1. Inspected construction of one bridge on “Ganganagar to Kalabari road” under BADP scheme. More than 30% work has been completed. The mistry was using sand drawn from nearby cherra for construction. The EE, RDD-I to call an explanation from I/O for using sub-standard materials and take action accordingly.
2. We started at 7:00 am from Gandacherra and reached by 9:00 am to the try junction of Girachandrapara by vehicles. Thereafter, we all alongwith SDM,GNC; BDO,DBN; SA; MOIC and some other sub-division level officials walked for around 10 kms to reach Bhagirathpara by 11:00 am..
3. On way we inspected Girachandrapara JB School, one proxy teacher Sri Nahindra Tripura was teaching the students in place of actual teacher Sri Sumendra Debbarma. He is being paid @Rs.1500/- per month. The mid-day-meal scheme works once in few month and the School building as this is being used at best place for keeping domesticate animals. ICDS centre was also not working.
4. Administrative camp was held at Bhagirath where number of patients attended the camp were very few. The Dr. Reang, MO reported that due to regular health camp, the health situation has improved and therefore, patients were not found in good number.
5. In the meantime, we walked on another 2 kms. towards water fall which can be developed as good tourist spot. The local people also requested for construction of one check dam on down stream of the fall which could be used as drinking water & irrigation source. The EE,RD-I may prepare an estimate for construction check dam (Raima).
6. Locals also demanded construction for taking up 2 diversion scheme over nearby up land which will extend irrigation over 4 hac of cultivable land. The project can be taken up under NREGA by the BDO,Dumburnagar.
7. The Bhagirath JB School where Administrative Camp was held, is not running due to obvious reason of teachers absenteeism.

8. On inauguration with around 60% to 70% local people, it was revealed that the job cards were returned back to them on the eve of my visit to Bhagirathpara. Some of them also reported as well as given in writing that the entries made in job cards was not as per date where they actually work. BDO,DBN to ensure action against the concerned Panchayet Secretary. For such irregularities, they also reported that the job card are actually take either in Panchayet Secretary nor elected leaders.

1. We had a detail discussion with the locals for checking out of action plan to develop Bhagirath village. After discussion, it was decided that the road from try junction
