

Tour Note

On **10-10-2009/(Second Saturday)** I started from Ambassa at **8:30 am** for Noonacherra re-grouping village. During the visit I was accompanied by Sri Vidya Bhushan, Asstt. Collector, IAS; Smt. Rakhi Biswas, SDM,Ambassa; Sri Jogendra Debbarma, O/C, NREGA & Sri M.K.Chowdhury, Dy. Director, PGP,Ambassa. The main points of the visit are as follows:-

Nunacherra Re-grouped Village:-

1. Inspected one rubber nursery centre raised by PGP Department from NREGA fund. The plants were of good quality and expected to be used during 2009-10 and 2010-11.

2. Dy. Director, PGP requested for placement of some officials from Agriculture, Horticulture, Fisheries Department under TTAADC on deputation to meet shortage in his office. The CEO, TTAADC can be requested for this purpose.

(Action by Dy. Director, PGP)

3. Nunacherra re-grouping colony consists of 250 families out of which 146 have been provided with IAY type house. This year 50 more families will be provided IAY type house from 2009-10 fund by the District Administration.

4. The people in regrouping village informed about shortage of teachers. The presently posted teachers at Chanmohanpara JB School are not attending schools, leading to lack of education to their children. Principal Officer, TTAADC, Education may kindly look into the matter. The mid-day-meal is provided occasionally. Teacher Sri Rajib Singh remains absent. Similarly, AWC is also functioning occasionally.

5. People informed that sufficient land is available in nearby place but they have not been given Forest Rights over this Forest land. Some local persons are resisting the conferring of rights to these families. SDM, Ambassa has been instructed to call a meeting with the regrouped families and local leaders to sort out the matter and ensure that preferably 10 kanis of land is given under Forest Rights to each families as desired by the State Govt.

6. The Dy. Director, PGP requested for providing sanitation facilities to the regrouped families. The Dy. Director to submit the requirement and accordingly fund will be placed from the TSC.

7. On request of the local, It was decided that financial assistance will be given to the deserving families for taking up some income generating activities, like piggeries etc. SDM,Ambassa has been instructed to submit a proposal within 10 days. The fund placed from TW Directorate for this purpose can be utilized.

8. All families have been provided around 100 days of work during 2009-10 by the Dy. Director PGP under NREGA. However, Forest Department has not provided even a single day of work from their departmental scheme.

Ganganagar:-

9. We had a detailed interaction at Ganganagar ADC village where most of the Chairpersons, Vice Chairpersons & Panchayet Secretaries of 7-ADC villages viz. Ganganagar, Chakmapara, Karmapara, Siddapara, Radharambari, Tetuiya, Karnamanipara were present. Discussion focused on better implementation of NREGA and Forest Rights Act.

10. Village Leaders reported that insurgency activities have increased in last couple of months and demand for collection of taxes by insurgents have also increased.

11. It has been reported that NREGA beneficiaries are facing problems in opening of bank account. However, it was clarified that all the NREGA beneficiaries have to open their accounts at TGB, Ambassa. The payment will be made at Ganganagar or at respective paras via smart card solution.

(Action by BDO, Ambassa)

12. Chairperson ADC Villages reported that Schools are not functioning in this area. The Purnajoy para SB School has got 3-contract teacher but it opens for few days in a month. The same situation prevails in Briskharam para JB School and Kolabari JB School. Principal officer, TTAADC look into the matter and ensure that Schools open in time. The contract teacher should not be paid salary if they do not run Schools. The action should also be taken against the erring teachers.

(Action by Principal officer TTAADC /Dy. Dir. Education, Dli)

13. Radharambari ADC village has got 2-mini deep tube wells but these are not functioning due to lack of electricity. At Siddapara electric poles have already been laid down but connection has not been provided. DGM, TSECL, Ambassa may take action accordingly.

(Action by DGM, TSECL, Ambassa)

14. Chairman & Panchayet Secretary raised issue of accommodation for Panchayet Secretaries and other **Govt. officials**. It was decided that the BDO, Ambassa may take up the construction of multi storied building for accommodation purpose out of the fund made available with him for capacity building for Panchayets under BRGF fund. If Panchayet Secretaries are provided accommodation they would stay at Ganganagar and it will help in better implementation of development works.

(Action by BDO, ABS)

15. The Chairman Radharambari informed that only 8-10 days of work per family has been given during 2009-10. BDO, Ambassa may look into the matter and may issue the work order under NREGA as per action place.

(Action by BDO, ABS)

Thereafter, I returned to Ambassa HQ by **4:20 pm.**
