

## Tour Note

On 03-03-2009, I started from Ambassa at 8:30 am for Chawmanu RD Block and reached by 10:30 am. I visited Chawmanu, Thalcherra under west Gobindabari to watch present health scenario and at 2:00 pm, I had a meeting with the Chairman, Chawmanu BAC; CDPO,CMN; EE,DWS; BDO,CMN; Addl. BDO, MNU; CMO,DLI; SDMO,LTV; MOIC,CMN. The minutes of the meeting on development activities issued separately. The main points of the visit follow :-

1. I inspected construction of Thalcherra Govt. Food Go-Down (PWD). The work has been completed till plinth level.

2. The progress in construction of Thalcherra Primary Health Centre at Longtharai Valley is slow. The EE, RD Dhalai will ensure an early completion of the work.

3. The BDO,Chawmanu to get existing masonry well cleaned at Thalcherra for supplying safe drinking water. He will also fit a new hand pump with the well.

4. "I inspected Mairungtwisa SB School. In Mairungtwisa (Thalcherra) S.B. School, two teachers are posted namely Sri Hemanta Tripura and Sri Alindra Tripura. During my visit the School was completely closed under lock and key. On local enquiry it was reported by them that the School had not been opened for around last 2(two) months. Sri Hemanta Tripura, teacher was found at his residence next to the School building. No records related to attendance, mid-day-meal, assets etc. could be made available by Sri Tripura. On being enquired some girls & boys who are supposed to be studding in the School, stated that they were not provided any mid-day-meal. On verification from the retail fair price shop, it was found that the rice was being lifted for the mid-day-meal regularly. All the tables, chairs, blackboards etc. were found in the teacher residence. On bring grilled, Sri Tripura accepted that the School was not being run regularly. He promised to make it regular within next 10(ten) days. The School has a strength of 109 students, as reported by the teacher. Some of the villagers had submitted complaints to the Inspector of Schools(IS) 2-3 times, however, no action was initiated against the teachers till date. (a copy of the complaint is enclosed) After my visit, I called the Dy. Director, Education, Dhalai and asked him to take action against the concerned teachers.

**(Action by Dy. Dir, Education)**

5. Next to the School, one AWC is also situated. After seeing, it could be easily made out that the centre had not been running for months together. On local enquiry, the villagers reported that the Aanganwadi worker got married 2(two) years back and thereafter she shifted from Thalcherra to Chawmanu. The Anganwadi worker has been rarely working. For this state of affair, it can be easily said that Anganwadi centre had not been running for last 2(two) years. The DISE, Dhalai to look into the matter replace the Anganwadi worker immediately and ensure that AWC start functioning in next 15(fifteen) days.

**(Action by DISE,DLI)**

6. I visited newly constructed health camp at 23 km. point TSR camp. I met Sri Biswajit Shil, MPW and Dr. Alak Das who are stationed at Health Centre. The BDO had

completed construction of 2(two) barracks one for Doctors and one other for patients. Another barrack will be constructed by BDO for staying of supporting medical staff.
