

**TOUR NOTE OF SRI VIKAS SINGH, IAS, DISTRICT MAGISTRATE & COLLECTOR,
DHALAI TRIPURA TO LALCHARA TMC HIGH SCHOOL & LAMBABILL HIGH
SCHOOL IN LONG THARAI VALLEY SUB-DIVISION ON 08-08-2016.**


The undersigned along with District Education Officer, Dhalai visited Lalchari TMC High School and Lambabill High School on 08-08-2016 to review the performance of Schools with respect to 0.0% pass percentage recorded during the Madhyamik Examination Result of 2016.

During visit of Lalchari TMC High School it was found that, out of total 156 nos. students there were 87 nos. students studying from Class-VI-X, out of which 30nos. students found to be present in the class which was very poor. Further, it was also found that the participation of parents in the SMC (Steering-cum Committee) meeting was also found to be very poor. During interaction with the 2nos. students of class-X, it was found that their knowledge and understanding with respect to lessons taught in the class was found to be good. The Headmaster/Principal of the school has been requested to improve the attendance of students in class particularly Class VI-X by conducting meeting with the parents. The students were also encouraged to motivate their classmates to attend the school regularly.

During the visit to Lambabill High school, it was found that out of total-171 nos. students, 119 nos. students attended the school from class VI-X out of which only 52 nos students found present which is very poor. It was found that out of 12 nos. teachers including Principal, 11 nos teachers were found to be present, 1(one) no. teacher was found on Casual Leave. Further, it was also found that the SMC (Steering-cum Committee) meeting was held 5 (Five) times during the year and the participation of parents in that meeting was very less. The Headmaster/Principal informed that 12 groups of student has been formed each under 1(one) teacher for monitoring of the students. The special classes were also held on Saturday and during free periods.

The Headmaster/Principal informed that some steps have been taken to ensure regular attendance of the students in the class by contacting with their parents in the nearby areas and motivating them to send their children to school. The Principal/Headmaster has been requested to take urgent steps for improvement of the attendance of the students in the school and the attendance of parents in the SMC (Steering-cum Committee) meeting.

The undersigned also visited the kitchen shed where the Mid-Day-Meal was being prepared. The quality of the Mid-Day-Meal was found to be O.K. The Headmaster/Principal informed that there is shortage of 426 kg of rice in the stock. The District Education Officer, Dhalai & SDM, Longtharai Valley, Sub-Division were requested to look into the matter immediately and take necessary steps for ensuring full stock of rice in the school.
